Susie Fitzhugh is a documentary photographer of education, social issues, children and families.

Recent clients include the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center, Annie E. Casey Foundation, the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia, and the University of Washington. Her stock images, which she manages herself, are used extensively in textbooks and educational magazines.

Susie is now documenting education in Seattle. She is working closely with Arts Corps (arts education), Denise Louie Education Center (preschool) the Seattle Public Schools (K-12), and various outdoor education programs. Doing so provides a rich library of current images for her stock photography clients.

Over the course of her career Susie's work has been featured in LIFE magazine, People, the Washington Post Magazine and in many publications about education and health care. Her photographs illustrated *Dooryard Garden* (Four Winds Press) and *Changes Everywhere* (Audubon/Golden Books). Her work has also been included in the photographic books *The Family of Children*, Time-Life Books' *Photographing Children*; *Athletes*; *The Dog - 100 Years*; *Game Face* and others.
